NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF AN ORDER (OTHER THAN AN ACQUISITION EXTINGUISHMENT ORDER) HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 ESSEX COUNTY COUNCIL PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2016 FOOTPATH 8 MISTLEY

On 20 June 2016 Essex County Council confirmed the above order made under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the order as confirmed is to divert public Footpath 8 commencing from a point at its connection with the most southern end of the public highway known as Dovehouse Farm Road (CO11 2QI), proceeding southerly at the field edge on the eastern side of the hedge boundary and continuing adjacent to and on the eastern side of the grass track for a distance of approximately 612 metres to where it then proceeds south westerly across the grass track and field corner, for a distance of approximately 204 metres to the existing exit at the field edge on the north side of the boundary ditch adjacent to Steam Mill Road, to an alternative route commencing from a point at the Parish boundary of Mistley and Bradfield, at the entrance to Dovehouse Farm where it connects to Dovehouse Farm Road, proceeding in a westerly direction on the metalled surface for approximately 19 metres then turning southerly with the concrete track adjacent to the eastern side of the conifer hedge for approximately 36 metres to the hedge corner, continuing southerly along the grassy track in Mistley Parish for a distance of approximately 720 metres to a point adjacent to Steam Mill Road, then proceeding west at the field edge on the northern side of the field boundary adjacent to Steam Mill Road for a distance of approximately 132 metres to the aforementioned existing exit where it continues unaffected across the ditch as shown on the order map.

A copy of the Order as confirmed and the Order map have been placed and may be seen free of charge at Tendring District Council Offices, Town Hall, Station Rd, Clacton-on-Sea CO15 1SE and at the Chelmsford Public Library, Market Road CM1 1QH during normal working hours. Copies are available on request from the Chelmsford Library at a charge.

The alternative route comes into force on 19 July 2016, and the old route shall be stopped up with effect from 26 July 2016, but if a person aggrieved by the order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 01 July 2016 make an application to the High Court
