

**The Essex County Council (Hanover Bridge (Bridge No. 2124) & Beeches Bridge
(Bridge No. 1877), Watery Lane, Rawreth) (Implementation & Revocation of 3 Tonne
Structural Weight Limit) Order 201***

The Essex County Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1-4 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. No vehicle, having a maximum permissible gross weight exceeding 3 tonnes, shall proceed on Hanover Bridge (Bridge No. 2124), Watery Lane, Rawreth in the District of Rochford, from a point approximately 225 metres north west of its junction with Hullbridge Road and Lower Road, north west for a distance of approximately 2.4 metres.
2. The Council is satisfied that for preventing the use of the road by vehicular traffic of a kind which, or its use by vehicular traffic in a manner which, is unsuitable having regard to the existing character of the road or adjoining property it is requisite that Section 3(1) of the 1984 Act should not apply in relation to this Order.
3. "The Essex County Council (Beeches Bridge, Beeches Road, Rawreth) (3 Tonne Weight Limit) Order 2009" is hereby revoked.
5. This Order shall come into operation on ***** and may be cited as The Essex County Council (Hanover Bridge (Bridge No. 2124) & Beeches Bridge (Bridge No. 1877), Watery Lane, Rawreth) (Implementation & Revocation of 3 Tonne Structural Weight Limit) Order 201*.
