## Zebra Crossing – Elm Tree Avenue, Walton-on-the-Naze

**Notice is hereby given** that under Sections 23 and 25 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the Essex County Council proposes to install a Zebra Crossing on the following length of Elm Tree Avenue, Walton-on-the-Naze in the District of Tendring as follows:

Road	Description
Elm Tree Avenue, Walton-on-the-Naze	The centre line of the proposed zebra crossing is to be located approximately 145 metres north of its junction with Edenside.
