

Public notice

Proposed 30mph Speed Limit, Long Road, Mistley

Notice is hereby given that Essex County Council proposes to make the above Orders under Sections 81, 82(1) & (2)(b), 83(2), 84(1) and (2) and Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended).

Effect of The Order:

To Implement: a '30mph Speed Limit' (Currently a 40mph Speed Limit), Mistley

Road	Description
Long Road	From a point approximately 41 metres east of its junction with the centre of The Avenue, westwards for approximately 28 metres.

'The Essex County Council (Tendring District) (Restricted Roads) (No.4) Order 2008' and 'The Essex County Council (Tendring District) (40mph Speed Limit) (No. 2) Order 2010' are hereby revoked insofar as it relates to the Parishes of Lawford and Mistley. All other roads not mentioned above shall remain in force by virtue of these new Orders.

To Amend: The lengths of the following restrictions are to remain the same on the ground, but the wording is being amended so that the measurements are correct. (Paper exercise), Mistley

Road	Description
B1352 Harwich Road	From its junction with New Road, eastwards to a point 235 metres east of its junction with Stourview Avenue, a distance of approximately 1612 metres.
