

## THE ARMY AND NAVY JUNCTION (CLASSIFIED ROAD) (SIDE ROADS) ORDER 2026

The Essex County Council (the "Council") hereby give notice that it has made, and is about to submit to the Secretary of State for Transport for confirmation, an Order made under sections 14 and 125 of the Highways Act 1980 authorising the Council to:

- a) improve the highways;
- b) stop up highways;
- c) construct new highways;
- d) stop up private means of access to premises; and
- e) provide new means of access to premises.

all on or in the vicinity of the route of the classified road known as the A1114 Essex Yeomanry Way; A1114 Van Dieman's Road; A1114 Princes Road; A138 Chelmer Road; and A1060 Parkway.
