THE ESSEX COUNTY COUNCIL ARMY AND NAVY JUNCTION (CLASSIFIED ROAD) (SIDE ROADS) ORDER 2026

The Essex County Council (“the Council”) makes this order in exercise of powers conferred by Sections 14 and 125 of the Highways Act 1980 (“the 1980 Act”) and all other powers enabling them in that behalf: -

- (1) The Council is authorised, in relation to the classified road in the district of the City of Chelmsford in the unparished area of Chelmsford and parish of Great Baddow to carry out the following works:
 - (a) improve the lengths of highway named in the Schedule to this Order and shown on the Site Plan by cross hatching;
 - (b) stop up the length of highway described in the Schedule and shown on the Site Plan by zebra hatching;
 - (c) construct a new highway along each route whose centre line is shown on the Site Plan by an unbroken black line surrounded by stipple;
 - (d) provide new means of access to premises at each location shown on the Site Plan by thin diagonal hatching; and
 - (e) stop up each length of private means of access described in the Schedule and shown on the Site Plan by solid hatching.
- (2) Where a new highway is to be constructed wholly or partly along the same route as a new access or part of one, that new highway shall be created subject to the private rights over that new access.
- (3) Each new highway is given a reference letter on the Site Plan, which is also placed in the Schedule, and will be a road unless the word “footpath” or “cycle track” appears beneath its reference letter in the Schedule, in which case it will be a footpath or cycle track (as the case may be). Each new access is given a number on the Site Plan, which is also placed in the respective Schedule.
- (4) Where a new highway is to be constructed or a new access is to be provided in connection with the stopping up of a length of highway described in the Schedule, its reference letter or number (as the case may be) is placed in the Schedule opposite the description of that length.
- (5) The Site Plan shows the works indicated in the Schedule and has the same number as the Schedule, and shows the route of the classified road in relation to the works.
- (6) Where immediately before a length of highway is stopped up in pursuance of this Order there is under, in, on, over, along or across that

highway any apparatus of statutory undertakers or any telecommunications code system operator, then, subject to section 21 of the 1980 Act, those undertakers, or that operator, as the case may be, shall have the same rights as respects that apparatus as they had immediately before the stopping up took place.

(7) In this Order: -

- (a) distances are measured along the route of the relevant highway or private means of access to premises, as the case may be.
- (b) a reference to a Schedule or Site Plan number is a reference to the Schedule, or to the Site Plan, so numbered.

“the classified road” means the;

A1114 Essex Yeomanry Way;
A1114 Van Dieman’s Road;
A1114 Princes Road;
A138 Chelmer Road; and
A1060 Parkway

which the Council propose to improve in the vicinity of the existing Army and Navy junction which has been classified by the Secretary of State for Transport as a principal road for the purpose of the enactments and instruments which refer to roads classified as principal road.

“the Council” means Essex County Council;

“improvement” in relation to a highway includes diverting, raising, lowering, or otherwise altering that highway, and “improve” and “improved” shall be construed accordingly;

“new access” means a means of access to premises authorised by this Order to be provided;

“new highway” means a highway authorised by this Order to be constructed and “new highways” shall be construed accordingly;

“Schedule” means a Schedule to this Order, and Schedules” shall be construed accordingly;

“Site Plan” means the plan contained in the Plan Folio marked “The Essex County Council Army and Navy Junction (Classified Road) (Side Roads) Order 2026”, sealed with the Common Seal of the Council and deposited at:

Locality: District of the City of Chelmsford in the unparished area of Chelmsford and Parish of Great Baddow.

HIGHWAY (S) TO BE IMPROVED

Baddow Road, Lynmouth Avenue, Goldlay Avenue, B1009 Baddow Road, Lady Lane, Van Dieman's Lane, Moulsham Chase, Meadgate Terrace, Meadgate Avenue and Tusser Court.

HIGHWAY (S) TO BE STOPPED UP

Part of the classified road known as A138 Chelmer Road located 132 metres east of the Army and Navy roundabout to be stopped up for a distance of 32 metres in an easterly direction and labelled S1 on the deposited Site Plan.	-
The entire length of the pedestrian underpass, associated ramps and hardened surface which passes beneath and through the Army and Navy Roundabout linking the classified roads known as the B1009 Baddow Road and A1060 Parkway for a distance of 145 metres and labelled S2 on the deposited Site Plan.	Various at grade non-motorised road user provisions within the classified road boundary
