- 1. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on hour on the said lengths of road, as specified in the schedule to this order. In the District of Braintree, as specified in the schedule to this order.
- 2. No speed restriction imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
