The Essex County Council (A1025, Gilden Way and Mulberry Green, Harlow) (Prohibition of Right-Hand Turn) Order 202*

The Essex County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1) and (2), and 2(1) to (3) of the road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

- 2. No person shall cause any vehicle travelling east on Mulberry Green to make a right-hand turn into the A1025 Gilden Way. [hereinafter referred to as the said length of roads] as specified in the schedule to this order.
- 3. No person shall cause any vehicle travelling south on the A1025 Gilden Way to make a right-hand turn into Mulberry Green [hereinafter referred to as the said length of roads] as specified in the schedule to this order.
- 4. The restriction imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restrictions or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
