The Essex County Council (Oakwood Drive (Purford Green) Harlow) (20mph Zone) Order 202*

Notice is hereby given that the Essex County Council proposes to make the above Orders under sections 84(1)(a) and 2, and Parts III of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended).

Effect of the order:

To Implement: 'a '20mph Zone' on the following length of roads, in the District of Harlow,

Road	Description
Oakwood Drive	From a point approximately 9 metres south of its junction with Little Brays (Approximately 80 metres west of the Purford Primary School entrance), for the rest of its remaining length, (approximately 190 metres), including private drives and turning heads.
