Colchester Road	From its junction with (B1027) Colchester Road southwest for approximately 28.5 metres

2. To Implement: a '50mph Speed Limit' (currently National Speed Limit 60mph)

Road	Direction
(B1027) Bypass	From a point approximately 120 metres east of its junction
Road	with Colchester Road south east for approximately 742.5 metres.
Clay Lane	From its junction with B1027 Bypass Road northeast for approximately 28 metres.

'The Essex County Council (Tendring District) (Restricted Roads) (No.4) Order 2008' and 'The Essex County Council (Tendring District) (40mph Speed Limit) (No.2) Order 2010' are hereby revoked in so much as they relate to the Parish of St Osyth, as specified in the schedule to this order.
