**The Essex County Council (Basildon Borough) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Amendment No.44)

Notice is hereby given that the Essex County Council proposes to make the above Order under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1), 4(2), 32(1), 35(1),45, 46, 49, 53, 81, 82(1) & (2)(b), 83(2) and Parts IV and III of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended).

1. To Implement: a '20mph Zone' (Currently a 30mph Speed limit)

Road Name	Description
Coxes Farm Road, Billericay	From a point approximately 12 metres north east of its junction with A129 Southend Road, north for approximately 145.5 metres,

2. To Implement: a '40mph Speed Limit' (Currently a 30mph Speed limit)

Road Name	Description
Coxes Farm Road, Billericay	From a point approximately 157.5 metres north east of its junction with A129 Southend Road, north for approximately 19 metres

'The Essex County Council (Coxes Farm Road, Great Burstead and South Green) (40MPH & Restricted Road) 2014 is hereby revoked in its entirety

3. To Revoke: Unrestricted Parking Bays **and To Implement:** '1 hour no return within 1 hour' Restrictions on the following lengths of roads:

Road Name	Description
Coxes Farm Road, Billericay	West Side i. From a point approximately 23.5 metres north east from its junction with A129 Southend Road north for approximately 42.5 metres ii. From a point approximately 83.5 metres north east of its junction with A129 Southend Road, north for approximately 26 metres.

4. To Implement: 'No Waiting at Any Time' Restrictions on the following lengths of roads:

Road Name	Description
Coxes Farm Road, Billericay	Both Sides i. From a point approximately 66 metres north east of its junction with A129 Southend Road north for approximately 17.5 metres. ii. From a point approximately 109.5 metres north east of its junction with A129 Southend Road, north for approximately 33 metres.
Proposed Access Road for Care Home.	Both Sides: From its junction with Coxes Farm Road west for approximately 8 metres

From a point approximately 120.5 metres from its junction with A129 Southend Road, north east for approximately 6.5 metres

The maximum height of the proposed raised table is approximately 100 millimetres, with a gradient of no greater than approximately 1 in 16 or 6.25%.
