

The Essex County Council (Coxes Farm Road, Great Burstead and South Green) (40MPH & Restricted Road) Order 2014

The Essex County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 81, 82(2), 83(2), 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act hereby makes the following Order: -

1. The length of roads specified in the Schedule to this Order shall become a restricted road for the purposes of Section 81 of the Act.
2. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on that length of roads Coxes Farm Road, Great Burstead and South Green in the Borough of Basildon, from a point approximately 180 metres north east of its junction with the A129 Southend Road in a generally north easterly and northerly direction, for a distance of approximately 1165 metres.
3. No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3 (5) of those regulations.
4. This Order shall come into operation on 31 March 2014 and may be cited as The Essex County Council (Coxes Farm Road, Great Burstead and South Green) (40MPH & Restricted Road) Order 2014.
