Proposed Implementation of a (Zebra) Pedestrian Crossing, Fambridge Road, Maldon

Essex County Council (Maldon District) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Amendment No.23) Order 202*

Notice is hereby given that the Essex County Council proposes to make the above Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1), 4(2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49, 53 and Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended).

Effect of the Order:

1. **To Revoke:** 'No Waiting At Any Time' Restrictions on the following length of Road,

Road	Description
Fambridge Road,	From a point approximately 5.5 metres north of the extended northern kerb line of Milton Road, north for approximately 14.5 metres.

2. **To Implement:** 'No Waiting At Any Time' Restrictions on the following length of Road,

Road	Description
Fambridge Road,	From a point approximately 46 metres north of the extended northern kerb line of Milton Road, north for approximately 11.5 metres.

This Order will be incorporated into the 'Essex County Council (Maldon District) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) Consolidation Order 2019' by substituting map tiles: TL850 057 Revision 2 to Revision 3 and TL850 060 Revision 0 to Revision 1

Notice is also hereby given that under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) the Essex County Council proposes **To Implement:** a Zebra Crossing on the following length of Fambridge Road.

Location of the crossing centre line	From a point approximately 25 metres north of the northern extended kerb line of Milton Road
Width between Stop lines:	Approximately 6 metres between stop lines
Length of zigzags	Approximately 17.5 metres either side of the crossing.
