

Public notice

The Essex County Council (Basildon Borough) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Amendment No.51) Order 202*

Notice is hereby given that Essex County Council proposes to make the above Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (4), 3(2), 4(1), 4(2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49, 53 and Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended).

Effect of the Order:

1. To Implement: 'No Waiting at Any Time' Restrictions on the following lengths of road.

Road	Description
Barrington Gardens	North West Side: From a point approximately 4.5 metres south west of the common property boundary of No's 50 and 52 Barrington Gardens, south west for approximately 7 metres South East Side: From a point approximately 2.5 metres south west of the common property boundary of No's 50 and 52 Barrington Gardens, south east for approximately 9.5 metres
Bower Lane	North East Side: i. From a point approximately 2 metres south east of the common property boundary of No's 19 and 21 Bower Lane, south east for approximately 2.5 metres ii. From a point in line with the common property boundary of No's 15 and 13 north west for approximately 4 metres South West Side: From a point approximately 2.5 metres south east of the common property boundary of No's 19 and 21 Bower Lane, south east for approximately 31 metres

This Order will be incorporated into The Essex County Council (Basildon Borough) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) Consolidation Order 2019 by substituting tiles: TQ720 897 Revision 1 to Revision 2 and TQ725 897 Revision 0 to Revision 1
