

Public notice

The Essex County Council (Windermere Drive and Various Roads, Great Notley) (20mph Speed Limit) Order 202*.

Notice is hereby given that the Essex County Council proposes to make the above Order under Sections 81, 82(1) and (2)(b), 83(2), 84(1)(a) and (2) and Parts IV and III of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended).

Effect of the order

- To Implement:** A 20mph Speed Limit in the District of Braintree (currently a 30mph Speed Limit).

Road	Description
Windermere Drive (north access)	From a point approximately 11.5 metres west from its junction with the Windermere Drive access road north west for approximately 700 metres
Windermere Drive (south access)	From a point approximately 12.5 metres west from its junction with the Windermere Drive access road north west for approximately 8.5 metres
Ennerdale Avenue	From its eastern junction with Windemere Drive west for its entire length - approximately 345 metres
Rydal Way	From its junction with Ennerdale Avenue for its entire length - approximately 225 metres
Grasmere Close	From its junction with Ennerdale Avenue east for its entire length - approximately 90 metres
Levens Way	From its junction with Ennerdale Avenue north west for its entire length - approximately 127 metres
Torver Close	From its junction with Windemere Drive north east for its entire length - approximately 110 metres
Langdale	From its junction with Windemere Drive/Derwent Way north for its entire length - approximately 140 metres
Derwent Way	From its eastern junction with Windemere Drive north for its entire length - approximately 610 metres
Buttermere	From its junction with Derwent Way north west for its entire length - approximately 140 metres
Ellen Way	From its junction with Derwent Way north for its entire length - approximately 300 metres
Skiddaw Close	At its western junction with Derwent Way east for its entire length - approximately 390m
Thirlmere Close	From its junction with Derwent Way south east for its entire length - approximately 90 metres
Gilpin Way	From its junction with Derwent Way north west for its entire length - approximately 190 metres
Coniston Close	From its junction with Derwent Way east for its entire length - approximately 80 metres
Crummock Close	From its junction with Windemere Drive north west for its entire length - approximately 196 metres
