## Traffic Management:

The HLO drew attention to the number of schemes marked green waiting to be funded and suggested that the panel should now be considering which schemes they would like funded as a priority in the next Budget and to let her know for discussion at the next meeting.

Cllr Egan referred to two schemes waiting validation and enquired when they would be considered for funding:

<u>Ref: 6: LCAS242003 – Church Road, Thundersley – Traffic Management</u> No railing outside school

<u>Ref: 12: LCAS242009 – Kents Hill Road North – Traffic Calming</u> Vehicles mounting pavement to pass oncoming vehicles.

The HLO advised all validations are being worked on now and will come back with a cost shortly if they are viable.

<u>Ref: 13: LCAS242010 – Daws Heath Road – Traffic Calming</u> The HLO confirmed that the new scheme will include white lineage, blind bend signage.

<u>Ref: 7: LCAS242004 – Roscommon Way – Horse Rider Signage</u> Engineer has advised there is adequate signage, but the HLO will ask for back-toback signage, if it is viable. Signage currently covered by foliage; Cllr May will speak to Morrisons.

<u>Ref: 9: LCAS242006 – Appleton Road, South Benfleet – Traffic Calming</u> Marked as red as not a speeding issue, but to be left on report pending further consideration.

### Walking:

<u>Ref: 1: LCAS222024 – Badger Hall Avenue – Dropped Kerb</u> To be marked "priority"

Ref 5: LCAS243001 – Link Road, Canvey Island – Traffic Calming

# CASTLE POINT LOCAL HIGHWAY PANEL REPORT 2 - SCHEMES AWAITING FUNDING LIST

Following a review of the LHP process, the allocation of the LHP capital budget will be adjusted for the upcoming period. The Panel is requested to provide funding recommendations for a two-year Rolling Programme of works, for which a total funding of £343,200 has been agreed for the Castle Point LHP.

To facilitate these funding decisions, the 'Schemes Awaiting Funding List' has been divided into two distinct reports:

**Report 2-A: Priority Schemes List** – This report details schemes that have completed the design phase and are ready for immediate implementation.

**Report 2-B: Schemes Awaiting Funding List** – This report encompasses all other schemes currently awaiting funding.

Panel members are advised to prioritise funding recommendations from Report 2-A in the first instance. Subsequently, any remaining budget can be allocated to schemes identified in Report 2-B.

Upon receipt of the scheme recommendations, a comprehensive programme will be developed, outlining delivery timelines for each selected scheme. An update on this programme, covering both financial years, will be presented at the next LHP meeting.

It should be noted that due to the LHP no longer validating new scheme requests, Report 2-B exclusively contains schemes that have undergone prior validation.

Please note that as the Chairmen's Panel will not convene during the 2025/26 financial year, schemes previously awaiting their funding decisions have now been reverted to the LHP's Schemes Awaiting Funding List.


