

Project Completion Notification

Footpath 13 Tilbury-Juxta-Clare Boardwalk E09-0065-006

Scheme objective:

The footpath runs through a wooded area, which is very wet in winter and prone to flooding. The original 50 metre wooden boardwalk through the wetland area has been in place for many years, and had started suffering rot and general deterioration as a result of its age, and has reached the end of its lifespan.

Therefore the objective of the scheme is to replace the boardwalk.

Scheme summary & outcome:

In order to eliminate any risks of environmental pollution from leachates from preservatives in timber, the new boardwalk will be made from recycled plastic.

To improve access for people in wheelchairs, kicking-boards will be installed on both sides for the full length as well as a passing bay at the half-way stage to enable wheelchair users to pass each other.

The initial works were clearing the vegetation from adjacent to the existing boardwalk to enable a clear working area thus reducing risks from trips and falls. The old boardwalk was then removed from site and replaced.

The scheme was completed the 3rd July 2020.


