The Essex County Council (Various Roads, Great Bentley) (20mph Zone, Restricted Roads and 30mph Speed Limit) Order 2024.

The Essex County Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 81, 82(2), 83(2), 84(1) and (2), and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") (as amended), and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act, hereby make the following Order: -

- No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on those lengths of road, in the District of Great Bentley as specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
- The lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order shall become restricted roads for the purposes of Section 81 of the Act.
- No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on the said lengths of Roads, Great Bentley in the District of Tendring as specified in schedule 3 to this order.
- The restriction imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restrictions or requirements imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
- No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4)
 of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment)
 Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
- This order shall come into operation on 20 May 2024 and may be cited as The Essex County Council (Various Roads, Great Bentley) (20mph Zone, Restricted Roads and 30mph Speed Limit) Order 2024.
- 'The Essex County Council (Various Roads, Great Bentley) (20mph Zone, Restricted Roads and 30mph Speed Limit) Order 2021' is hereby revoked in its entirety however, any roads not mentioned below shall continue in force by virtue of this new Order.
