## Harlow Sustainable Transport Corridor: Fifth Avenue – Zelenskyy Avenue A1019

### **Road Closure: Fifth Avenue – Zelenskyy Avenue A1019**

On behalf of Essex County Council, Bouygues UK Ltd are undertaking essential works on Fifth Avenue – Zelenskyy Avenue A1019 as part of the Harlow Sustainable Transport Corridor project.

**As a result of these works, nighttime road closures will take place on Fifth Avenue – Zelenskyy Avenue A1019 in both directions between the Burnt Mill Roundabout and the Sainsbury's Roundabout. These closures will take place on three nights, at the following dates and times:**

- From 8pm on Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> September to 5am on Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> September 2025
- From 8pm on Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> September to 5am on Friday 26<sup>th</sup> September 2025
- From 8pm on Friday 26<sup>th</sup> September to 5am on Saturday 27<sup>th</sup> September 2025

Please note that these works are weather dependent. Therefore, in the event that any of the above closure dates cannot take place due to inclement weather, the following two contingency dates may be required for nighttime road closures on Fifth Avenue – Zelenskyy Avenue A1019:

- From 8pm on Saturday 27<sup>th</sup> September to 5am on Sunday 28<sup>th</sup> September 2025
- From 8pm on Sunday 28<sup>th</sup> September to 5am on Monday 29<sup>th</sup> September 2025

The nighttime road closures on Fifth Avenue – Zelenskyy Avenue A1019 are required to carry out surfacing works, with a full closure needed to ensure both the safety of the public and workforce.

Due to the nature of this work, there will be no access for vehicles travelling on Fifth Avenue – Zelenskyy Avenue A1019 during these closure periods, including the emergency services. **However, access and egress from Gladwin Way will be maintained for residents, to and from the Burnt Mill Roundabout via Fifth Avenue – Zelenskyy Avenue A1019.** There will be a clearly signed diversion route during this closure, with a map detailing the closure location and diversion route included below.

A certain amount of inconvenience is inevitable with work of this type, and we greatly appreciate your patience whilst these works are being undertaken. Unfortunately, this work will unavoidably create some noise, and we sincerely apologise for any disturbance caused. We wish to assure you that we will undertake these works as efficiently and quickly as possible.
