Notice is hereby given that the above Order made by Essex County Council, under s14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, has been continued in force with the consent of the Secretary of State for the Department for Transport until 15 July 2021.

Effect of the order: To temporarily close that length of Footpath 32, Henham, in the District of Uttlesford, from a point approximately 10 metres either side of Elsenham Emergency Hut Network Railing Crossing.

The alternative route will be Footpath 14 Ugley, Bedwell Road, New Road, Old Mead Road and vice versa.

The closure commenced on 15 July 2020 and is required for the safety of the public due to insufficient sighting for pedestrians to cross the foot crossing safely and the presence of high speed trains.
