A414 Latest Progress So Far

We have completed the capping layer from the Gates Ford dealership to Harlow Mill roundabout and continue to lay granular stone in preparation for the kerb to be laid.

At the River Way roundabout on Edinburgh Way we have completed the excavation for the new road. We have also completed the capping layer along the route and have started laying the kerb stones.

At the East Road Corner section there are gas pipes that need diverting and Morgan Sindall are liaising with Cadent to achieve this as soon as possible.
