A414 Latest progress so far

During December we have:

Completed the drainage along the southern side of the scheme, continued excavating the box cut to the southern side completing 200m. Identified a number of services that are within the box cut and had the relevant body on site to identify what is live or dead. Prepared Harlow Mill Roundabout for grass guard installation, and completed all ducting installation to Harlow Mill Roundabout.



No Right Turns
