

Dear Sir / Madam

As you may be aware works are due to commence to land adjacent to the Hospital approach on July 24th, the works are on behalf of Countryside Developments and are to include a road widening scheme North of the existing carriage-way. Works are expected to last 16 weeks and will include major gas and water diversions.

It is envisaged that for certain periods, traffic lights will be required so as to provide a safe working zone, protecting our workforce from the live traffic. The current dates for these lights will be September 27th through to November 10th, Monday to Friday. This will inevitably cause a certain amount of disruption for journeys that involve the use of the approach road and we respectfully request that an alternative route(s) be used if possible. The lights will be erected in off-peak hours so as to minimise disruption during work / school journeys, between the hours of 9.00am and 3.00pm.

The traffic management proposals will be available to view on the County Council website and details will also be available with the on-site team. At present no total road closures are envisaged for these works, only temporary lane closures within the hours stated.

Whilst we appreciate that the up and coming works will cause an element of disruption, they are necessary, and it is our intention to complete these works as quickly and as efficiently as possible.
