1. WELCOME AND INTRODUCTION.

The Chairman Councillor J Knapman welcomed those Members present and those attending in an observational role.

2. DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST SCHEME RECOMMENDATIONS 2016/17

There were no declarations of interest pursuant to the Council's Code of Member Conduct.

3. MINUTES

RESOLVED:

That the minutes of the meeting held on Tuesday 7th June 2016 be taken as read and signed by the Chairman as a correct record.

4. EPPING FOREST DISTRICT CYCLING ACTION PLAN

The Senior Transport Planner provided a presentation to the LHP Members following the outcome of the Cycling Action Plan. The Members were advised that if they have any follow up question to contact J Dowding directly.

The HLO to provide the Members with his contact details.

5. SCHEME UPDATE - B181 EPPING ROAD J/W COMMON ROAD, BROADLEY COMMON (LEPP151004)

The Chairman and HLO explained the administrative error with regards to this Casualty Reduction scheme and that the original estimated delivery cost was £30,000 and not £12,000.

There has been 4 further collisions at this location which has taken the total to 13 collisions in the last 5 years.

The scheme has been out to tender with our supply chain partners and they have returned a delivery cost of £27,191.

The Panel Members unanimously supported the top up of £15,200 and the scheme will be programmed for delivery within Quarter 3 of the financial year.

Item 6 - B181 Lindsey Street, Epping; VAS by Shaftesbury Farm going west. Scheme to remain on the list and previous survey to be passed to Cllr Whitehouse.

Item 7 – Severns Field, Epping; Salt bin request. The criteria wasn't met as the gradient wasn't greater than 5%. Scheme to be removed from list.

Item 9 – Kendal Avenue, Epping; Traffic calming measures. HLO to discuss with Cllr Avey.

Item 12 – The Street, Ongar; Traffic calming measures. The speed survey highlighted good compliance. Scheme to be removed from list.

Item 13 – Various, Loughton; Salt bin requests. Further clarification needed on comments and HLO to update Cllr Pond and Cllr Metcalfe.

Item 14 – Pyrles Lane, Chester road, Hillyfields; A number of improvement measures. The RAG to be changed to Amber.

Item 18 – Laundry Lane; no through road or install lockable gate; after discussion it was agreed that this project would be re-examined by ECC Highways to determine feasibility. This would include a consultation and petition from the residents. To be progressed.

The HLO would update Councillor Pond on the Church Hill, Loughton S106 scheme.

The Chairman advised the Panel that the HLO would update the Members on the 'Hail & ride' bus service.

9. FUTURE MEETING ARRANGEMENTS

Members agreed that the next meeting of the LHP would be held at the Civic Offices on Tuesday 13^{th} December 2016 at 6.00pm.

CHAIRMAN

Oakwood Hill (LEPP152003)

The above scheme was recommended by the Epping Forest LHP Members within the 2015/16 financial year for delivery with an allocated budget of £10,000. Once commissioned, a level 1 estimate was undertaken that identified an additional £4,000 would be required to ensure the scheme could be designed and delivered. Standard construction methods, which is normal for these type of schemes.

During scheme development unforeseen issues can be encountered, this can alter the volumes of materials and method of construction. In this particular case, the supply chain identified during the competitive tender that the standard method of working would not allow them to construct the works successfully. They have identified that a road closure and diversion would be required to ensure these could be constructed safely. Of which a further top up of £5,000 is required.

Schemes are only tendered at the end of design, at the point we were made aware of the issue. We have challenged all the supply chain partners on their method of work, and have received acknowledgment that while this is far from ideal, it is the only practical solution.

The finances are as follows:

Current Budget - £14,000

Overall costs

Delivery Cost - £11,115.56 Diversion Cost - £3,240.13

Design Costs - £4,149 (Detailed design, Road Safety Audit, Commercial, Topographical survey and ECC legal fees for processing road closure and advert) Total Costs - £18,504.69

As the scheme is now ready for delivery I would be grateful for your support with a top up of £5,000. The scheme can be programmed for delivery within Quarter 4 subject to the agreement of the top up.

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EPPING FOREST DISTRICT COUNCIL WITH ESSEX COUNTY COUNCIL LOCAL HIGHWAY PANEL – 13th DECEMBER 2016 POTENTIAL CAPITAL SCHEMES

As part of the Essex County Council 2017/18 budget it is believed that the Capital budget for the Epping Forest Local Highways Panels (LHP) will remain the same as that for 2016/17. This would mean for Epping Forest LHP the available 2017/18 capital budget will be £349,775. It is recommended for 2017/18 that the Panel make further scheme funding recommendations to create a £450,000 rolling programme of highway improvement works.

This Potential Scheme List identifies all of the scheme requests which have been received for the consideration of the Epping Forest LHP. The Panel are asked to review the schemes on the attached Potential Scheme List, prioritising those schemes they would like to make 2017/18 funding recommendations against and remove any schemes the Panel would not wish to consider for future funding.


