**NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF AN ORDER
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980
ESSEX COUNTY COUNCIL
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2020
FOOTPATH 7 AYTHORPE RODING**

On 19th August 2020 Essex County Council confirmed the above order made under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the order as confirmed is to divert a part length of Footpath 7 Aythorpe Roding commencing from grid reference 55825,21434 and running in an easterly direction across the ditch then continuing in a north north easterly direction crossing the River Roding for a distance of 292 metres to grid reference 55833,21461 to a new route commencing at the same above point and running in a generally northerly then a generally north north westerly direction on the west side of the ditch for a distance of 238 metres to grid reference 55819,21455 then continuing in an east north easterly direction crossing the River Roding running along the south side of the ditch for a distance of 148 metres to the same above point where it continues unaffected.

The alternative route comes into force on 16th September 2020, and the old route shall be stopped up with effect from 23rd September 2020, but if a person aggrieved by the order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 3rd September 2020 make an application to the High Court.
