This Order is made by Essex County Council (“the authority”) under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 (“the 1980 Act”) because it appears to the authority that in the interest of the owner of the land crossed by the footpath described in paragraph 1 of this order it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

The landowner has agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this order and any expenses incurred in the order making and bringing the new site of the path into a fit condition for use by the public.

Uttlesford District Council have been consulted and have consented to the making of the order as required by section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER:

- 1) The public right of way over the land situated at Aythorpe Roding known as Footpath 7 in the District of Uttlesford and shown by a bold continuous black line on the order map numbered AYROD 7A contained in this order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this order shall be stopped up after 35 days from the date of confirmation of this order.

- 2) There shall at the end of 28 days from the date of confirmation of this order be a public footpath over land situated at Aythorpe Roding known as Footpath 7 in the District of Uttlesford as described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken black line on the order map numbered AYROD 7A contained in this order.

SCHEDULE

(PART 1)

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATH OR WAY

A part length of Footpath 7 Aythorpe Roding of unknown width shown by a bold continuous black line on the order map commencing from point **A** at grid reference 55825,21434 running in an easterly direction across the ditch then continuing in a north north easterly direction crossing the River Roding for a total distance of approximately 292 metres to point **C** at grid reference 55833,21461.

(PART 2)

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW PATH OR WAY

A footpath being 2 metres in width shown by a bold broken black line on the order map commencing at the aforementioned point **A** running in a generally northerly then a generally north north westerly direction on the west side of the ditch for a distance of approximately 238 metres to point **B** at grid reference 55819,21455 then continuing in an east north easterly direction crossing the River Roding running along the south side of the ditch for a final distance of approximately 148 metres to the aforementioned point **C** where it continues unaffected.

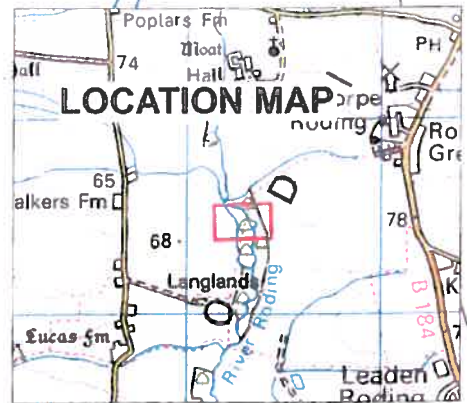
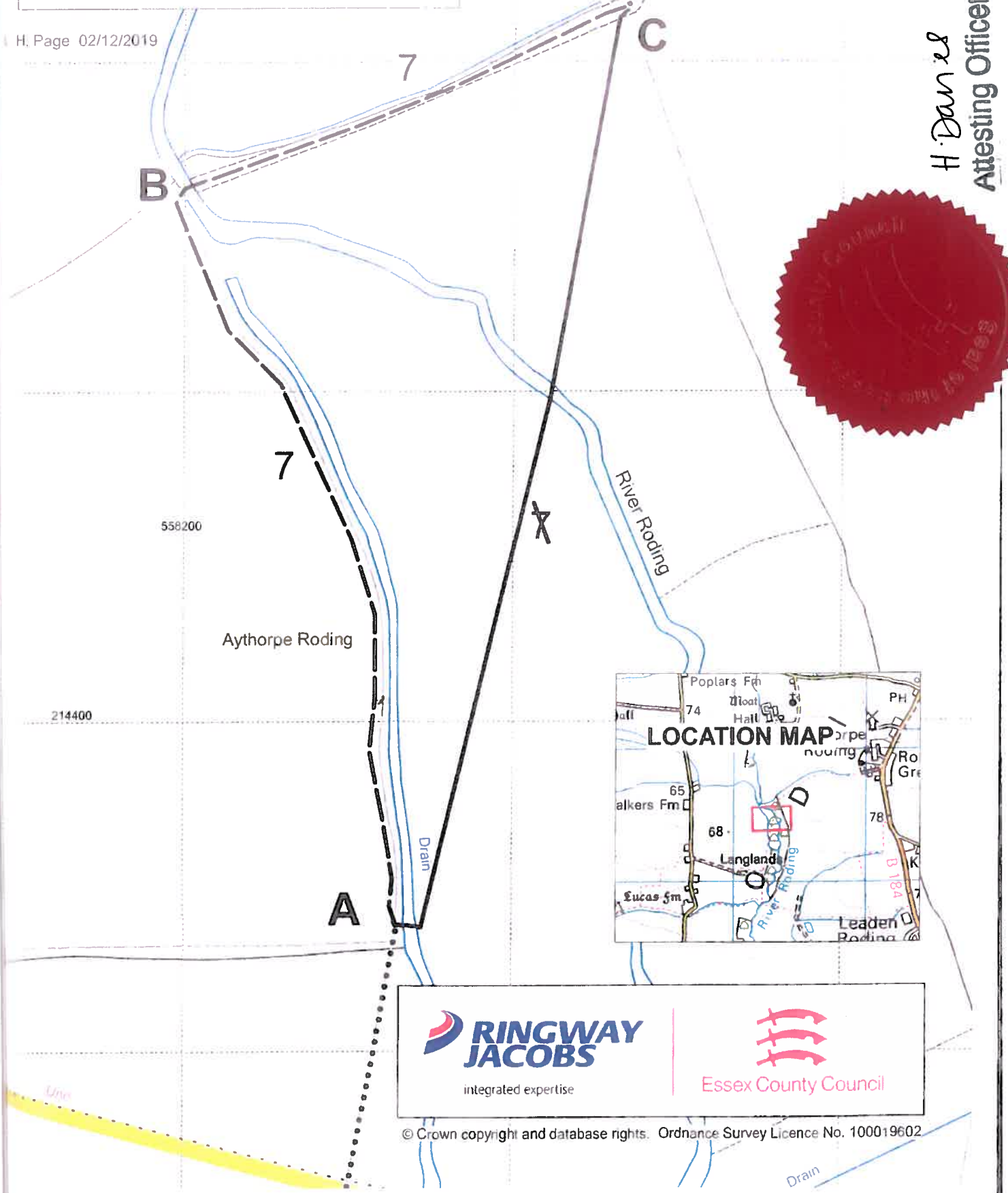
Plan No. AYROD 7A
