**CHELMSFORD CITY COUNCIL  
NOTICE OF MAKING OF AN ORDER  
TOWN & COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990 – SECTION 257  
FOOTPATHS 8 AND 16 BOREHAM**

Chelmsford City Council Planning granted Beaulieu Outline Planning Permission (Ref:09/01314/EIA) Dated 7 March 2014 and Radial Distributor Road (Phase 2B) (REF: 17/02039/REM) Dated 27 April 2018, which necessitate the re-routing of the footpaths.

The above orders, made on 4 September 2020, under section 257 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990, as shown on the order maps will divert:

## Footpath 8 Boreham

A part length of Footpath 8 Boreham commencing from a point 25 metres north east of Park Farm Cottage running in a north easterly direction for a distance of 95 metres to a point where it continues unaffected, to an alternative route 3.5 metres in width commencing at the aforementioned start point running in a generally north easterly then north, north westerly then generally north, north easterly direction for a distance of 97 metres to a point where it then continues in a south easterly direction for a distance of 49 metres to the aforementioned end point where it continues unaffected.

## Footpath 16 Boreham

A part length of Footpath 16 Boreham commencing from a point located 43 metres north east of its connection to Generals Lane/Footpath 8 Boreham running in a generally north easterly direction for a distance of 462 metres to the point where it connects to Footpath 15 Boreham and continues unaffected, to an alternative route 3.5 metres in width commencing at the aforementioned start point running in a generally north easterly direction for a distance of 470 metres to a point where it connects to Footpath 15 Boreham 14 metres south east of the aforementioned end point.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, Chelmsford City Council may confirm the Order as an unopposed order. If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation any representations or objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent together with the Order. Any such representation or objections will be taken into account by the Council with the result that they may be made available to the public under the Local Government (Access to Information) Act 1985.
