**NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF AN ORDER
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980
ESSEX COUNTY COUNCIL
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2020
BRIDLEWAY 9 HATFIELD HEATH**

On 19 August 2020 Essex County Council confirmed the above order made under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the order as confirmed as shown on the order map is to divert a part length of Bridleway 9 Hatfield Heath commencing from grid reference 55195,21544 on the existing track and running in a northerly direction across the garden of Field House for a distance of 150 metres to grid reference 55195,21559 will be diverted to a new route commencing at the same above point and running in a generally north north westerly direction along the existing track for a distance of 128 metres to grid reference 55193,21557 then continuing in a north easterly then northerly then an easterly direction for a distance of 36 metres to the same above point where it continues unaffected.

Documents can be made available for inspection 8.30am-4.30pm Mon-Fri at Essex County Council, County Hall, E block main reception, Market Road, Chelmsford if so required following the current social distancing restrictions. The alternative route came into force on 16 September 2020, and the old route shall be stopped up with effect from 23 September 2020, but if a person aggrieved by the order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 24 September 2020 make an application to the High Court.
