**NOTICE OF MAKING OF AN ORDER  
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980  
ESSEX COUNTY COUNCIL  
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2020  
BRIDLEWAY 47 AND FOOTPATH 45 HERONGATE AND INGRAVE**

The above order, made on 8 July 2020, under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980, as shown on the order maps will divert:

**Bridleway 47 Herongate and Ingrave**

A part length of Bridleway 47 Herongate and Ingrave being 2.5 metres in width commencing from a point on the access drive to heron Hall running in a generally northerly direction along the access drive for a distance of 27 metres to its junction with Footpath 57 Herongate and Ingrave then continuing in a generally northerly then generally easterly direction along the access drive for a final distance of 95 metres to a point on a farm track east of farm buildings where it continues unaffected, to an alternative route 3 metres in width commencing at the aforementioned start point running in an east north-easterly then a north easterly then continuing in a north north-easterly direction for a total distance of 114 metres to the aforementioned end point where it continues unaffected.

**Footpath 57 Herongate and Ingrave**

A part length of Footpath 57 Herongate and Ingrave being of 1.25 metres in width commencing from its junction with Bridleway 47 running in a north north-westerly then a west north-westerly direction for a total distance of 99 metres along the access drive to a point on a farm track south west of Heron Hall where it continues unaffected, to an alternative route 2 metres in width shown commencing at the aforementioned start point running in first a generally northerly then north westerly direction for a distance of 107 metres across a grass area to the aforementioned end point where it continues unaffected

Any such representation or objections will be taken into account by the Council with the result that they may be made available to the public under the Local Government (Access to Information) Act 1985.
