The Essex County Council Definitive Map Modification No. 635 (Footpath 19 Mayland, Maldon District) Order 2017

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs on 16 April 2020 confirmed the above mentioned Order with modifications and it took effect on that day.

The effect of the Order is to modify the Definitive Map for the County of Essex by:-

Adding a length of public footpath along Seaview Parade from North Drive in an easterly direction for a distance of approximately 75 metres . The width of the way is 3.1 metres.

If any person is aggrieved by this Order and desires to question its validity on the ground that it is not within the powers of section 53 or that any of the requirements of Schedule 15 have not been complied with in relation to it, he may within 42 days from the date of publication of this Notice make an application to the High Court under paragraph 12(1) of Schedule 15 to the Act.
