NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF AN ORDER HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

PUBLIC PATH EXTINGUISHMENT ORDER 2020 PART OF FOOTPATH 12 ALPHAMSTONE DISTRICT OF BRAINTREE

On 08 July 2020, Essex County Council confirmed the above order made under section 118 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the order as confirmed is to extinguish a part length of Footpath 12 Alphamstone starting from grid reference 58747,23524 at the highway known as Pebmarsh Road and running in a generally north westerly direction through the grounds of the property known as Alphamstone House then in a northerly direction across the field then continuing in a north easterly direction through dense undergrowth then in a north westerly direction for a total distance of 400 metres to grid reference 58736,23556 where it connects to Footpath 30 as shown on the order map.

Documents can be made available for inspection 8.30am-5.30pm Mon-Thurs and 8.30am-5pm on Friday at Essex County Council, County Hall, E Block main reception, Market Road, Chelmsford if so required following the current social distancing restrictions. The order comes into force on 06 August 2020, but If a person aggrieved by the order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 23 July 2020 make an application to the High Court.
