**NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF AN ORDER
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980
ESSEX COUNTY COUNCIL
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2020
FOOTPATH 52 SOUTH HANNINGFIELD**

On 3 June 2020 Essex County Council confirmed the above order made under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the orders as confirmed as shown on the order maps is to divert a part length of Footpath 52 South Hanningfield of unknown width shown by a bold continuous line on the Order Map commencing from a point 5 metres east of the connection with Footpath 40 running in an easterly then south easterly direction for a distance of 76 metres to a point on the south east corner of the property garden boundary where it continues in a generally east, north easterly direction along the field edge on the northern side of a hedge line for a distance of 93 metres to a point north of the existing footbridge, to an alternative route 2 metres in width commencing from the aforementioned start point running in a south, south easterly direction along a property access for a distance of 53 metres to the point where it meets the publicly maintainable highway and continues with a variable width of between 1.5 and 3 metres in first an easterly then east, north easterly direction between opposing land boundaries for a further distance of 142 metres to a point south of the existing footbridge where it runs briefly in a northerly direction for a final distance of approximately 1 metre to cross the boundary and connect to the aforementioned end point.

Documents can be made available for inspection 8.30am-5.30pm Mon-Thurs and 8.30am-5pm on Friday at Essex County Council, County Hall, E block main reception, Market Road, Chelmsford if so required following the current social distancing restrictions. The alternative route comes into force on 1 July 2020, and the old route shall be stopped up with effect from 8 July 2020, but if a person aggrieved by the order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 9 July 2020 make an application to the High Court.
