**NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF AN ORDER
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980
ESSEX COUNTY COUNCIL
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2020
FOOTPATHS 28 AND 36 WETHERSFIELD**

The above Order was confirmed by the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food & Rural Affairs on 13 July 2020 under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980. The effect of the orders as confirmed as shown on the order maps is to divert:

1. a part length of Footpath 28 Wethersfield commencing from grid reference 57293,22974 on the south side of Valley Farm running in a west south westerly direction for a distance of 148 metres to grid reference 57279,22969 to a new route commencing at grid reference 57301,22963 and running in a west south westerly direction to grid reference 57286,22958 then continuing in a west south westerly direction and finally in a north westerly direction all along the field boundary for a total distance of 276 metres to grid reference 57276,22958 where it connects to the current line of Footpath 28.

2. a part length of Footpath 36 commencing from grid reference 57284,22989 and running in a south easterly then south south easterly and finally in a west south westerly direction for a distance of 200 metres then continuing in a south easterly direction along the existing track for a final distance of 112 metres to grid reference 57300,22964 will be diverted to a new route commencing at the same above starting point and running in a west south westerly direction across the field for a distance of 121 metres to grid reference 57273,22984 then continuing in a south south easterly direction for a final distance of 294 metres to grid reference 57286,22958 where it connects to Footpath 28 Wethersfield.

The alternative route comes into force on 10 August 2020, and the old route shall be stopped up with effect from 17 August 2020 but if a person aggrieved by the order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 23 July 2020 make an application to the High Court.
