I do not know of anyone using this footpath in the last 25 years. In its 200 or so yards length, it runs through the curtilage of an elderly, widowed lady and the curtilages of two other working households and is potentially a privacy and a security hazard for all these people. In the recent past, the Parish Council has sanctioned the diversion of paths that intrude on the privacy of residents (Roslyns, Paddock View), but, in this case, there seems to be little reason for the path to exist at all. Pedestrians can and do walk alongside Drapers Lane and Camps road both of which have wide level grass verges in these sections. An extra 30 yards, but preferable to pushing through other people's washing. I remember when the sign at the other end of the path went up, dear old Derek (Rest his soul) had twizzled it round so that it pointed down Drapers Lane before the cement had dried. The path does not impinge in any way on Lancelots Farm.

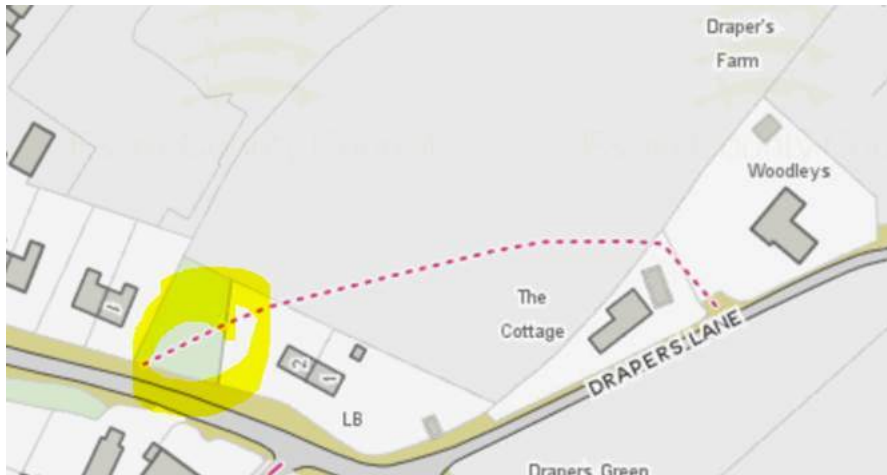

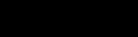

There already exist highway verges (excepting ditches) alongside both roads and we would not have the ability to expand those or to change their status.

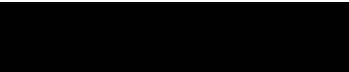
Creating a replacement route around the front of the houses would also require consent of a 3rd party landowner (unaffected by the current PROW) and them giving up some of their frontage.

In this case I really do not believe it is necessary as I am confident that the proposal already fully meets the s118 tests, notwithstanding the Rambler's opposition to that legal mechanism, the law specifically allows for landowners to apply under Section 118 and for orders to be made where the criteria is met.

Drapers Lane is a no-through road and so one could assume that it does not have much (lorry/ large vehicle) traffic. I am well and enjoying the summer, as I hope you are.

In terms of Chair of Essex Rambler, and I do not to appear pedantic , but I am just the Spokesperson. The object is to keep the ROW operation together but ignore the admin duties required of the Chair.

I am also Area Footpath Secretary and in that role I ensure the Footpath Secretaries follow the requirements laid down by the Ramblers.

To clear up the first point, the Ramblers accept the requirements of s118.

Thank you for the map, it made everything clear, and showed the reason for your judgement that the FP met the s118 criteria.

There is an alternative, and used route, it effects no other footpath, it has not been used for some time and no one has reported its blockage. In other words it would not be missed.

Which brings me to [REDACTED]'s submission.

A meaningful objection needs to address the s118 criteria. This does not provide reasons why this should not occur but just asks for the path to be reopened. The statement that the Ramblers are in principle opposed to extinguishments, may be correct but, as we both know, does not stop extinguishments happening.

As the Rambler Essex Area Footpath Secretary I am unable to support [REDACTED] in this.

I hope you are keeping well?

Simon Taylor advised that he thought you were currently the acting Essex Ramblers Chairman? If so, congratulations.

Do you mind if I ask a question, please in respect of the above?

I have an ongoing (inherited) s118 application for a very short footpath which passes through three residential property gardens (normal houses, not large homes and so very impactful) and connects to a publicly maintainable carriageway at either end – one is a quiet country road, and the other is a very quiet dead-end road. Neither road has a footway associated with it and there isn't any direct PROW connection to the footpath, so if anyone did want to use it, they would already have needed to have walked in both roads.

In our assessment it fully meets the s118 criteria and, going through three property gardens, is the sort of situation that the DEFRA Presumptions guidance was designed for.

I know it is easier to see than explain so I have attached the order map for you to consider.

I received an objection from [REDACTED] on deadline day (yesterday), which I am yet to respond to as I am a bit concerned that it is not criteria-based and that the wording may imply that the Ramblers are not accepting of the relevance of the s118 criteria in determining whether to make or confirm an order and have not given due consideration to the DEFRA Presumptions guidance.

The reason given for the objection was as follows:

*"We visited the site on Friday 18 July.
The only part of the footpath that was not walkable was the woodland at the Camps Road end.
There was no visible fingerpost and no visible gap. Google streetview from October 2008 shows a fingerpost and a gap.*

We would ask that this section of the footpath be cleared and made available.

The Ramblers are in principle opposed to extinguishments."

Of course, in an ideal world all applicants and the HA would first make definite routes fully available, but from a resource and enforcement perspective that is not always proportionate or a good use of resources.

The experience of many PINS referrals evidences that PINS do not in any way insist upon this or take it into consideration one way or the other – in short, they disregard current/temporary obstructions and focus on the need or otherwise for a PROW.

I am most concerned though about sentence which implies that the Ramblers are not basing decisions on the s118 criteria or giving due consideration of the Presumptions Guidance.

As you know where there are diversion options in the gift of an applicant then we direct them to pursue that option, but that is not the case here and I think that by any reasonable consideration this a PROW that is not needed for public use.

I would welcome your thoughts as I do not feel that there would be any valid reason for us not making an order in this case.
