**NOTICE OF MAKING OF AN ORDER
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980
ESSEX COUNTY COUNCIL
PUBLIC PATH EXTINGUISHMENT ORDER 2026
FOOTPATH 7 HELIONS BUMPSTEAD**

The above order, made on 26 March 2026 under section 118 of the Highways Act 1980, will extinguish the entire length of Footpath 7 Helions Bumpstead of unknown width shown by a bold continuous line on the order map commencing from point A at grid reference 56451,24255 where it connects to Camps Road running in a north easterly then south easterly direction through boundary features gardens and a paddock for a total distance of approximately 156 metres to point B at grid reference 56466,24256 where it meets Drapers Lane and terminates.

Copies of the orders and order maps can be requested to be posted or viewed by emailing publicpathorders@essexhighways.org to arrange a suitable time to inspect the documents quoting the Order title. Documents can be made available for inspection 8.30am-4.30pm Mon-Fri at Essex County Council, County Hall, E block main reception, Market Road, Chelmsford if so required following the current social distancing restrictions. Please state the grounds on which they are made and which order they refer to.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, Essex County Council may confirm the Order/s as unopposed. If the Order/s are sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation any representations or objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent together with the Order/s. Any such representation or objections will be taken into account by the Council with the result that they may be made available to the public under the Local Government (Access to Information) Act 1985.

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**(Camps Road, Helions Bumpstead)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2026**

Notice is hereby given that the Essex County Council has made the above Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

Effect of the order: To temporarily close that length of Camps Road, Helions Bumpstead in the District of Braintree, from a point approximately 580m north west, north east then north west of its junction with Church Hill for a distance of approximately 85m in a north westerly direction. The closure is scheduled to commence on 26th May 2026 for 1 day, or where stated on a valid permit (BC008PLT3161441130032025 - Openreach Limited). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signs showing and/or displayed on one.network. The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while pole testing works are undertaken by Openreach Limited.

An alternative route is available via Camps Road, Drapers Green, Park Lane, Bartlow Road, Camps End, Olmstead Green, Sages End Road, Camps Road and vice versa.

The Order came into effect on 8th May 2026 and may continue in force for 18 months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the earlier.
