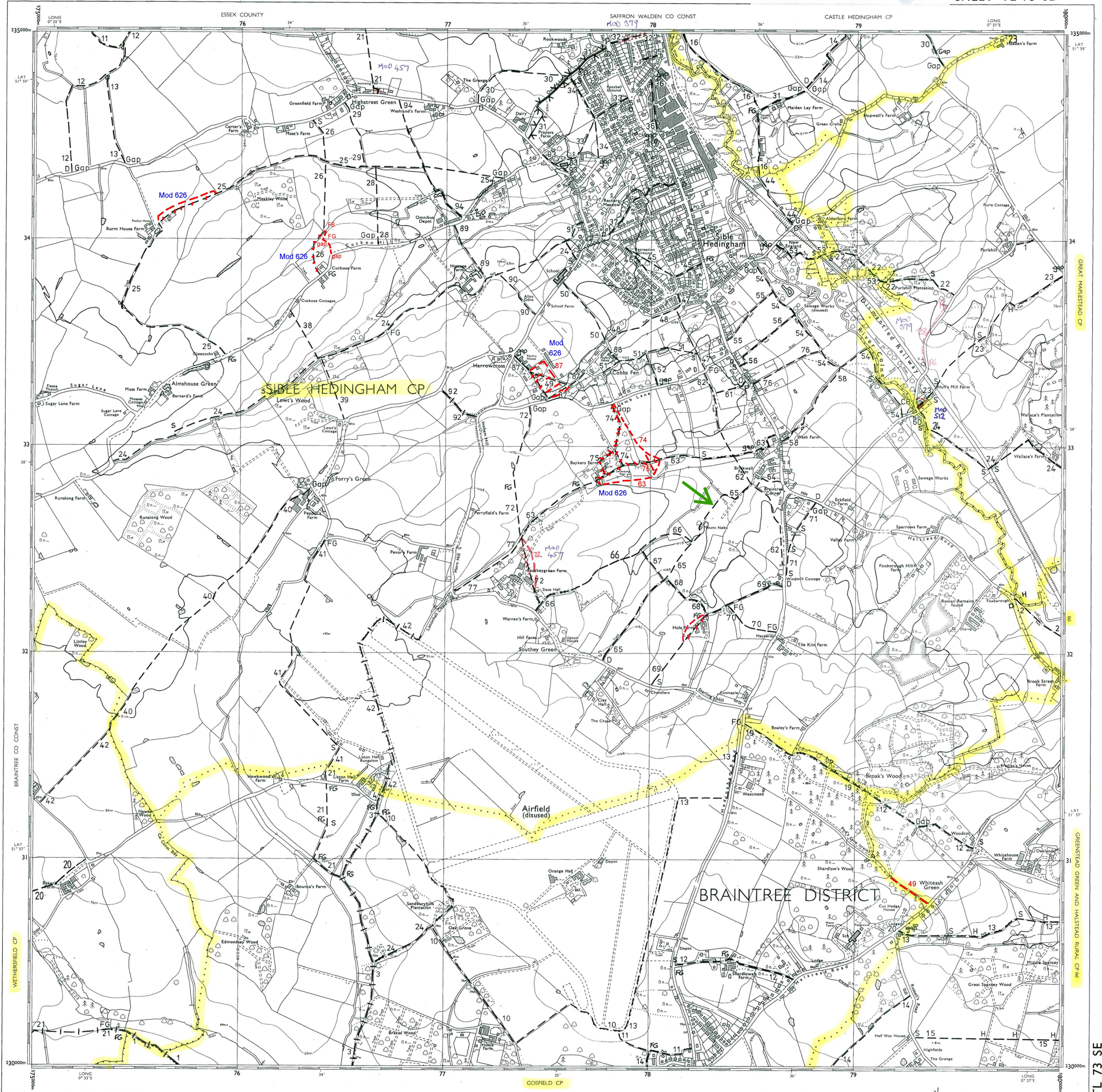




EXTRACT FROM THE DEFINITIVE

73SE	63	FP	From Bridge House in a south-westerly direction to its junction with footpath 72 north of Southey Green Farm.		
73SE	64	FP	From Queen Street, A604, leading west and south-west to its junction with footpath 62. Approximate width 1.25 metres.		
73SE	65	FP	From its junction with footpath 62 in a south-westerly direction to the road near Southey Green Pottery.		
73SE	66	FP	From its junction with footpath 65 near Mount Nebo in a south-westerly direction to the road near Warren's Farm.		
73SE	67	FP	From its junction with footpath 66 in a south-easterly direction to its junction with footpath 65.		
73SE	68	FP	From its junction with footpath 65 in a south-easterly direction to its junction with footpath 69 near Hole Farm.		
73SE	69	FP	From the Windmill public house in a south-westerly direction to the road south-east of Southey Green Pottery.		
73SE	70	FP	From its junction with footpath 69 in a south-easterly direction to the road opposite Tile Kiln Farm.
