NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF AN ORDER
TOWN & COUNTRY PLANNING ACT SECTION 257
FOOTPATH 16 BOREHAM
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2022

The above Order, confirmed on 11 February, 2022 under section 257 of the Town & Country Planning Act 1990 will divert a part length of Footpath 16 in the parish of Boreham.

Chelmsford City Council Planning granted Beaulieu Outline Planning Permission (Ref:09/01314/EIA) Dated 7 March 2014 and Radial Distributor Road (Phase 2B) (REF: 17/02039/REM) Dated 27 April 2018, which necessitate the re-routing of the footpath.

A part length of Footpath 16 Boreham commencing from a point located 43 metres north east of its connection to Generals Lane/Footpath 8 Boreham running in a generally north easterly direction for a distance of 462 metres to the point where it connects to Footpath 15 Boreham and continues unaffected, to an alternative route 3.5 metres in width commencing at the aforementioned start point running in a generally north easterly direction for a distance of 470 metres to a point where it connects to Footpath 15 Boreham 14 metres south east of the aforementioned end point.

In accordance with s257 paragraph 8 of schedule 14 to the above Act notice is hereby given that on 13 January 2022 Essex County Council on behalf of Chelmsford City Council certified that the replacement rights of way required under the terms of the above order have been created to its reasonable satisfaction.
