**NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF AN ORDER
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2026
BRIDLEWAY 183 BRENTWOOD
IN THE BOROUGH OF BRENTWOOD**

On 14/09/2026, Essex County Council confirmed the above order made under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980. The effect of the order as confirmed is to divert a part length of Bridleway 183 Brentwood, commencing from a point at grid reference 55874,18864 Postcode CM13 3JT north of the Southend Arterial Road and south west of Codham Hall, proceeding in a north-westward direction through a storage compound to a point outside its north western corner fencing, to an alternative route commencing from the aforementioned point south west of Codham Hall, proceeding west south-westward adjacent to and outside the storage compound fencing to the eastern side of Codham Hall Wood, where it continues northward adjacent to the wood to the aforementioned point north west of the storage compound fencing connecting to the unaffected part of Bridleway 183 Brentwood, as shown on the order map,

The document can be made available for inspection from 8:30am-4:30pm Mon-Fri at Essex County Council, County Hall, E block main reception, Market Road, Chelmsford CM1 1QH. The alternative route comes into force on 13/10/2026 and the old route will be stopped up with effect from 20/10/2026, but if a person aggrieved by the order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 24/09/2026, make an application to the High Court.
