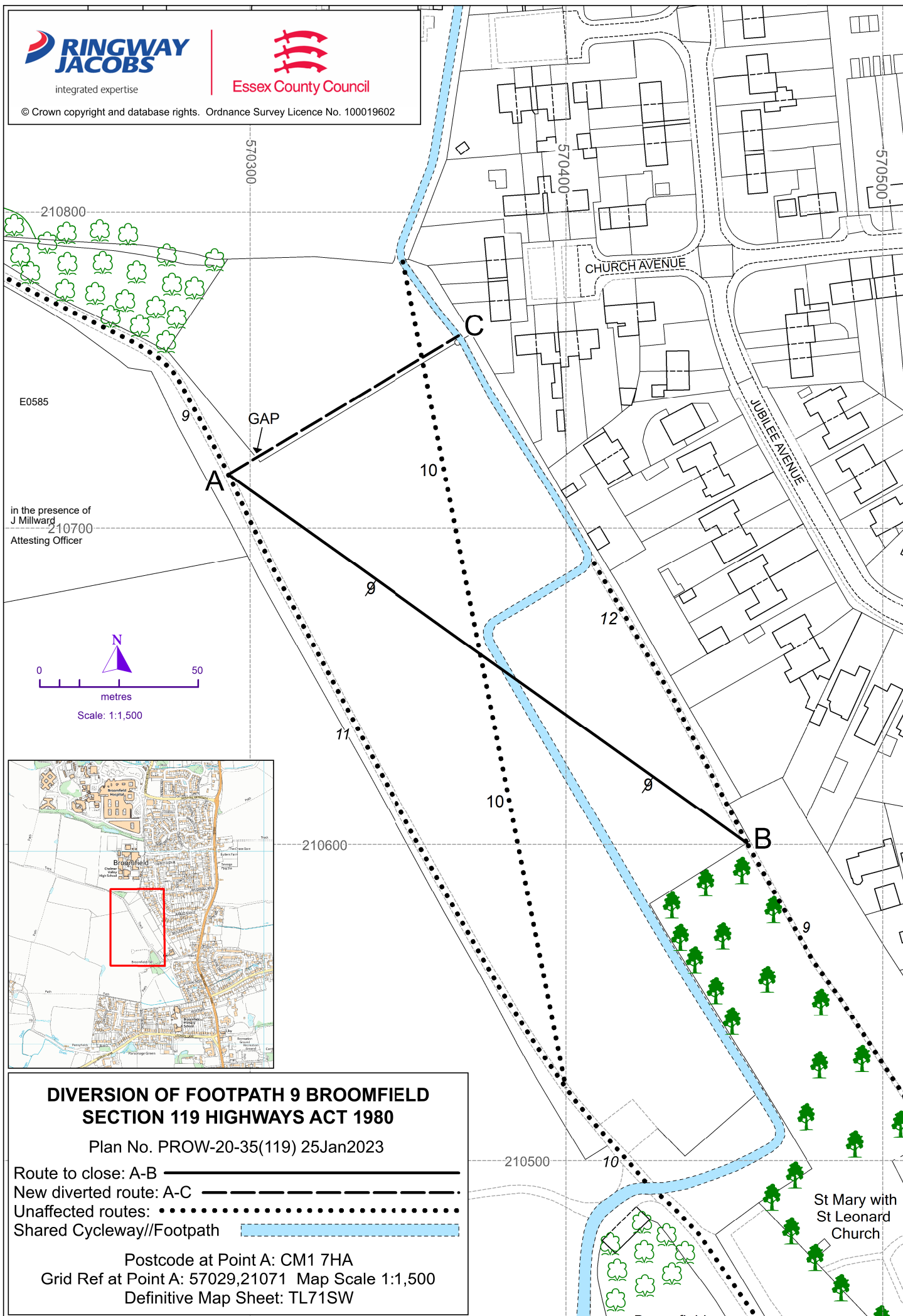
This Order is made by Essex County Council (“the authority”) under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 (“the 1980 Act”) because it appears to the authority that in the interests of the owners of the land crossed by the footpath described in paragraph 1 of this order it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

The order is being funded by the authority as part of the Chelmsford City Growth Package and the authority will defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this order and any expenses which are incurred in the order making and bringing the new site of the path into a fit condition for use by the public.

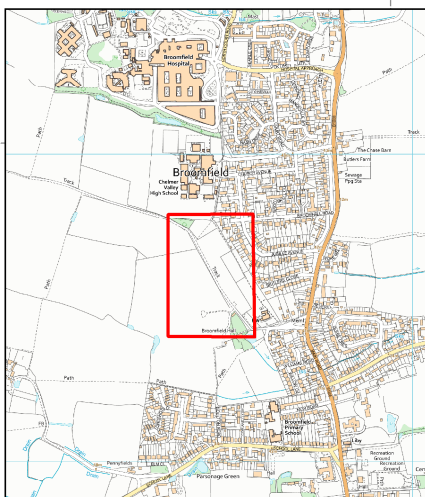
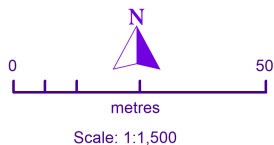
Chelmsford City Council have been consulted as required by section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER:

1. The public right of way situated over land north west of St Mary with St Leonard Church known as Footpath 9 Broomfield in the City of Chelmsford and shown by a bold continuous line on the order map PROW-20-35(119) 25Jan2023 contained in this order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this order shall be stopped after 35 days from the date of confirmation of this order.
2. There shall at the end of 28 days from the date of confirmation of this order be a public footpath over land situated north west of St Mary with St Leonard Church in Broomfield in the City of Chelmsford as described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the order map PROW-20-35(119) 25Jan2023 contained in this order.
3. The rights conferred on the public under this order shall be subject to the limitations and conditions set out in Part 3 of the Schedule.

SCHEDULE

PART 1

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATH OR WAY

A part length of Footpath 9 Broomfield of unknown width shown by a bold continuous line on the order map commencing from Point **A** at grid reference 57029,21071 at its connection with Footpath 11 Broomfield west of Jubilee Avenue proceeding in a south eastward direction across the crop field then grass area for a total distance of approximately 200 metres to Point **B** at grid reference 57045,21060 north west of St Mary with St Leonard Church.

PART 2

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW PATH OR WAY

A footpath being 2 metres in width shown by a bold broken line on the order map commencing from the aforementioned Point **A** at its connection with Footpath 11 Broomfield proceeding in a north eastward direction through the fence gap then adjacent to the boundary fence on its northern side for a total distance of approximately 85 metres to Point **C** at grid reference 57036,21075 connecting with the new Cycleway/Footpath south westward of Church Avenue.

PART 3

LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

1. A GAP of 1 metre width at grid reference 57030,21072 as shown on the Order Map (PROW-20-35(119) 25Jan2023) between the fence and gate	The right of the landowner to limit and maintain a gap subject to its removal should the boundary fence be removed whereby a width of 2 metres shall be provided, this being the dedicated width of the path as specified in Part 2 of the Schedule
