This Order is made by Essex County Council (“the authority”) under section 118 of the Highways Act 1980 (“the 1980 Act”) because it appears to the authority that the footpath described in paragraph 1 below is not needed for public use.

Chelmsford City Council have been consulted as required by section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER:

1) Part sections of the public right of way over the land situated east and west of the A131 known as Footpath 4 Great and Little Leighs in the City of Chelmsford and shown by a bold continuous line on the order map numbered PROW-23-39 contained in this order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this order shall be extinguished on the confirmation of this order.

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATH OR WAY TO BE EXTINGUISHED


A part length of Footpath 4 Great and Little Leighs of unknown width shown by a bold continuous line on the order map commencing from point **A** at grid reference 57344,21937 where it connects to Footpath 2 Great and Little Leighs running in a south easterly direction within a wooded area for a distance of approximately 207 metres to point **B** at grid reference 57362,21926 where it meets the northbound lane of the A131. A further section of Footpath 4 commencing at point **C** at grid reference 57364,21924 where it connects to the southbound lane of the A131 running in a south easterly direction between hedges for a final distance of approximately 78 metres to point **D** at grid reference 57371, 21920 where it terminates at its connection with London Road.



