NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF AN ORDER HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER FOOTPATH 166 HARLOW

On 30 January 2024 Essex County Council confirmed the above order made under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the order as confirmed is to divert a part length of Public Footpath 166 Harlow, commencing at its junction with London Road CM17 9LU proceeding in a generally eastward direction along Kennels Lane for approximately 360 metres to grid reference 54760,21094 west of The Kennels, to an alternative route commencing at the junction of London Road at the new footway on the north side of Kennels Lane proceeding in an eastward direction parallel with Kennels Lane for approximately 360 metres to grid reference 54760,21095, where it then heads southward and re-joins the unaffected part of Footpath 166 Harlow as shown on the order map.

The alternative route comes into force on 27/02/2024 and the old route will be stopped up with effect from 05/03/2024, but if a person aggrieved by the order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 08/02/2024 make an application to the High Court.
