## NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF AN ORDER HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 ESSEX COUNTY COUNCIL PUBLIC PATH EXTINGUISHMENT ORDER 2025 FOOTPATH 26 HIGH LAVER

On 14 March 2025 Essex County Council confirmed the above order made under section 118 of the Highways Act 1980, as shown on the order maps will extinguish a part length of Footpath 26 High Laver of unknown width shown by a bold continuous line on the order map commencing from the point where it connects to Footpath 25 High Laver running in a northerly direction through a garden for 135 metres to a ditch crossing at the boundary of a garden then continuing in a north westerly direction across a field for a final distance of 98 metres to where it connects to Footpath 27 High Laver and continues unaffected.

The route shall be stopped up with effect from 18 April 2025, but if a person aggrieved by the order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 27 March 2025 make an application to the High Court.
