This Order is made by Essex County Council (“the authority”) under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 (“the 1980 Act”) because it appears to the authority that in the interest of the owner of the land crossed by the footpath described in paragraph 1 of this order it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

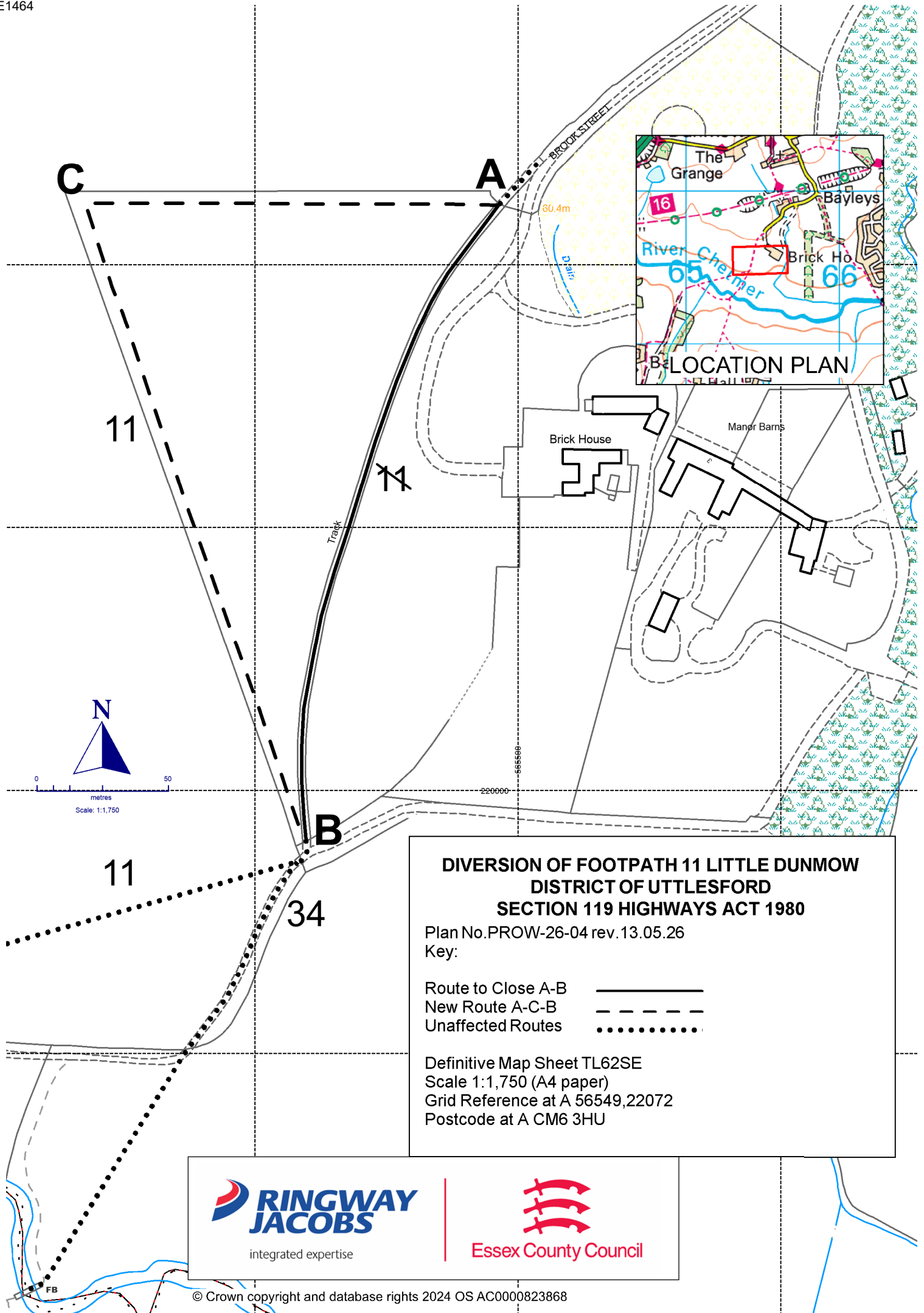
The landowner has agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this order and any expenses incurred in the order making and bringing the new site of the path into a fit condition for use by the public.

Uttlesford District Council have been consulted as required by section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER:

1) The public right of way over the land situated west of Brick House known as Footpath 11 Little Dunmow in the District of Uttlesford and shown by a bold continuous line on the order map numbered PROW-26-04 rev.13.05.26 contained in this order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this order shall be stopped up after 35 days from the date of confirmation of this order.

2) There shall at the end of 28 days from the date of confirmation of this order be a public footpath over land situated west of Brick House known as Footpath 11 Little Dunmow in the District of Uttlesford as described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the order map numbered PROW-26-04 rev.13.05.26 contained in this order.

SCHEDULE

(PART 1)

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATH OR WAY

A part length of Footpath 11 Little Dunmow at a width of 2 metres shown by a bold continuous line on the order map commencing from point **A** at grid reference 56549,22072 located approximately 22 metres south of the footpath's connection to Brook Street running in a south south westerly direction between boundary features for a total distance of approximately 257 metres to point **B** at grid reference 56541,22048 where it continues unaffected.

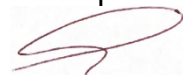
(PART 2)

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW PATH OR WAY

A footpath being 2 metres in width shown by a bold broken line on the order map commencing at the aforementioned point **A** running in a westerly direction along the top of a wooded area for a distance of approximately 156 metres to point **C** at grid reference 56533,22072 where it continues in a south easterly direction along the side of a wooded area skirting mature trees and running adjacent to a headland for a final distance of approximately 253 metres to the aforementioned point **B** where it continues unaffected.
