NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF AN ORDER HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

PUBLIC PATH EXTINGUISHMENT ORDER FOOTPATH 53 LITTLE BURSTEAD IN THE BOROUGH OF BASILDON

On 03/08/2023 Essex County Council confirmed the above order made under section 118 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the order as confirmed is to extinguish the public footpath commencing from a point at grid reference 56631,19149 at its junction with Footpath 52 Little Burstead east of Chase Farm buildings proceeding in a south westward direction across the agricultural field to its junction with Footpath 79 Little Burstead southeast of the farm buildings, as shown on the order map.

The order comes into force on 31/08/2023, but if a person aggrieved by the order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 17/08/2023 make an application to the High Court.
