**NOTICE OF MAKING OF AN ORDER  
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980  
ESSEX COUNTY COUNCIL  
PUBLIC PATH EXTINGUISHMENTS ORDERS 2026  
FOOTPATHS 23 & 50 STANSTED MOUNTFITCHET**

Footpath 23 Stansted Mountfitchet

The above order, made on 23 March 2026 under section 118 of the Highways Act 1980, will extinguish a part length of Footpath 23 Stansted Mountfitchet of unknown width shown by a bold continuous line on the order map commencing from point A at grid reference 55147,22482 where it connects to Church Road adjacent to Bridge House running in first a north north westerly then north easterly direction down steps then continuing between property boundaries and the railway line for a total distance of approximately 87 metres to point B at grid reference 55155,22486 where it connects to Footpath 50 Stansted Mountfitchet and continues unaffected.

Footpath 50 Stansted Mountfitchet

The above order, made on 23 March 2026 under section 118 of the Highways Act 1980, will extinguish a part length of Footpath 50 Stansted Mountfitchet of unknown width shown by a bold continuous line on the order map commencing from point A at grid reference 55151,22476 where it connects to Church Road south of Elms House running in a north easterly then generally northerly direction through an outbuilding and boundary features including a fence then continues across and along Dairy Lane for a total distance of approximately 105 metres to point B at grid reference 55155,22485 located approximately 7 metres south of its connection to Footpath 23 Stansted Mountfitchet where it leaves the adopted highway and continues unaffected.
