**NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF ORDERS
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980
ESSEX COUNTY COUNCIL
PUBLIC PATH EXTINGUISHMENT ORDERS 2026
FOOTPATHS 23 AND 50 STANSTED MOUNTFITCHET**

On 15 July 2026 Essex County Council confirmed the above orders made under section 118 of the Highways Act 1980. The effect of the orders as shown on the order maps as confirmed is to extinguish:

Footpath 23 Stansted Mountfitchet

A part length of Footpath 23 Stansted Mountfitchet of unknown width shown by a bold continuous line on the order map commencing from point A at grid reference 55147,22482 where it connects to Church Road adjacent to Bridge House running in first a north north westerly then north easterly direction down steps then continuing between property boundaries and the railway line for a total distance of approximately 87 metres to point B at grid reference 55155,22486 where it connects to Footpath 50 Stansted Mountfitchet and continues unaffected.

Footpath 50 Stansted Mountfitchet

A part length of Footpath 50 Stansted Mountfitchet of unknown width shown by a bold continuous line on the order map commencing from point A at grid reference 55151,22476 where it connects to Church Road south of Elms House running in a north easterly then generally northerly direction through an outbuilding and boundary features including a fence then continues across and along Dairy Lane for a total distance of approximately 105 metres to point B at grid reference 55155,22485 located approximately 7 metres south of its connection to Footpath 23 Stansted Mountfitchet where it leaves the adopted highway and continues unaffected.

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The routes shall be stopped up with effect from 15 July 2026, but if a person aggrieved by the orders wants to question their validity, or that of any provision contained in them, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Orders, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 23 July 2026 make an application to the High Court.
