This Order is made by Essex County Council (“the authority”) under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 (“the 1980 Act”) because it appears to the authority that in the interest of the owner of the land crossed by the footpath described in paragraph 1 of this order it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

The landowner has agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this order and any expenses incurred in the order making and bringing the new site of the path into a fit condition for use by the public.

Epping Forest District Council have been consulted.

BY THIS ORDER:

- 1) The public right of way over the land situated immediately to the north of the properties collectively known as Colemans Farm in the parish of Theydon Mount and known as Footpath 8 Theydon Mount in the District of Epping Forest and shown by a bold continuous line on the order map numbered PROW-22-29 contained in this order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this order shall be stopped up after 35 days from the date of confirmation of this order.
- 2) There shall at the end of 28 days from the date of confirmation of this order be a public footpath over land situated immediately to the north of the properties collectively known as Colemans Farm in the parish of Theydon Mount and known as Footpath 8 Theydon Mount in the District of Epping Forest as described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the order map numbered PROW-22-29 contained in this order.

Unaffected Routes

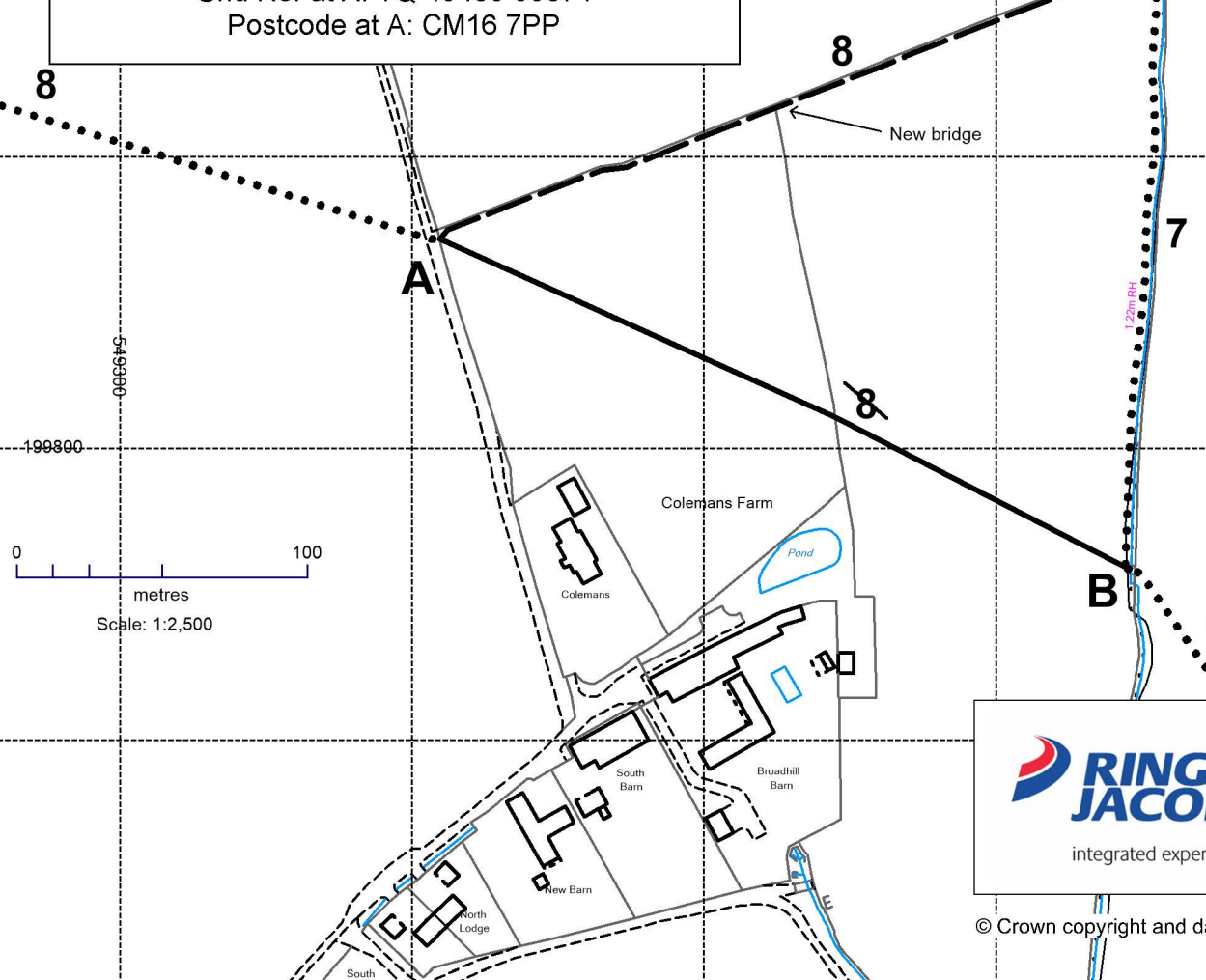
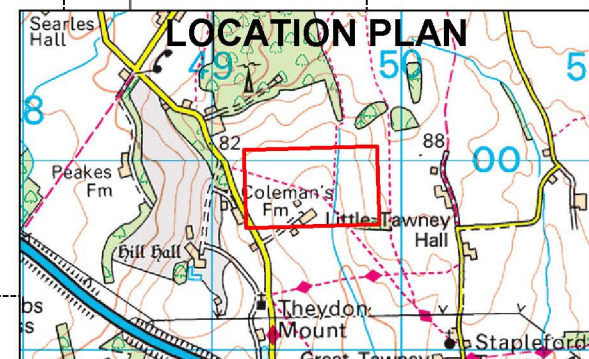

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATH OR WAY

A part length of Footpath 8 Theydon Mount of unknown width shown by a bold continuous line on the order map commencing from point **A** at grid reference TQ 49409 99871 running in a south easterly direction across two fields for a total distance of approximately 260 metres to point **B** at grid reference TQ 49647 99759.

(PART 2)

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW PATH OR WAY

A footpath being 2 metres in width shown by a bold broken line on the order map commencing at the aforementioned point **A** running in a north easterly direction along the northern edge of the two fields for a total distance of approximately 263 metres to point **C** at grid reference TQ 49656 99965.
