**NOTICE OF MAKING OF AN ORDER
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980
ESSEX COUNTY COUNCIL
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2025
FOOTPATH 16 WOODHAM WALTER**

The above order made on 27 March 2025 under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980, as shown on the order maps will divert a part length of Footpath 16 Woodham Walter of unknown width shown by a bold continuous line on the order map PROW-24-23 rev.15.10.24 commencing from a point at the corner of a farm track running in a generally southerly direction along the track through a patio area and along a grass verge for a total distance of 76 metres to a point where it joins the established path where it continues unaffected, to an alternative route 2 metres in width commencing at the aforementioned start point running in a south westerly direction along the farm track for a distance of 21 metres to a point at a bend in the track where it continues in a south easterly then southerly direction along the farm track for a final distance of 79 metres to the aforementioned end point where it continues unaffected.

A further section of Footpath 16 Woodham Walter of unknown width shown by a bold continuous line on the order map PROW-24-30 rev.04.11.24 commencing from a point at the north east corner of a wooded area running in a south westerly direction within a wooded area for a total distance of 212 metres to the point where it connects to Tom Tit Lane, to an alternative route 2 metres in width commencing at the aforementioned start point running in first a southerly then generally south westerly direction around the eastern perimeter of the wooded area for a total distance of 233 metres to a point located 10 metres south west of the aforementioned end point where it connects to Tom Tit Lane.
