NOTICE OF MAKING OF AN ORDER  
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980  
ESSEX COUNTY COUNCIL

## PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER FOOTPATHS 5 AND 11 CHICKNEY IN THE DISTRICT OF UTTLESFORD

The above order, made on 21 October 2020, under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980, will divert as shown on the order map:

1) a part length of Footpath 5, commencing from a point at the edge of the arable field east of St Mary's Church CM6 2BY (grid ref: 55746,22805), proceeding north eastwards across the field to the foot of the earth embankment, continuing north-northeast through the meadow then across the corner of the lake to its north eastern corner at grid ref 55760,22833, to an alternative route commencing from the aforementioned point east of St Mary's Church, proceeding north eastwards across the field to the fence boundary at grid ref: 55756,22820, then continuing south eastward on the eastern side of the fence to the foot of the earth banking, continuing north eastward past the pill box and across the meadow to the south eastern corner of the lake, then northward adjacent to the lake to the aforementioned point at its north eastern corner.

2) a further part length of Footpath 5 commencing from a point in the copse north of the lake at grid ref: 55760,22839, proceeding generally north westward through the copse to the field edge, then continuing across arable field corner north westward to join the field edge adjacent to the brook at grid ref: 55718,22897, to an alternative route commencing from the aforementioned point in the copse proceeding generally westward through the copse to the field corner at the edge of the copse, continuing north westward at the field edge to the north western corner of the copse, then north east to the edge of the field adjacent to the brook and following the brook north westward to the aforementioned point at grid ref: 55718,22897.

3) a part length of Footpath 11 commencing from a point at its junction with Footpaths 5 and 8 Chickney adjacent to St Mary's Church, proceeding north eastward across the grass, through the hedge and across the arable field to its far corner then continuing through the scrub and then eastward across the meadow to a point approximately 12 metres west of the brook at grid ref: 55773,22809, to an alternative route commencing from the aforementioned point west of the brook proceeding generally north westward across the meadow to connect to the diverted section of Footpath 5 north east of the pillbox.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, Essex County Council may confirm the order as an unopposed order. If the order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation any representations or objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent together with the order. Any such representations or objections will be taken into account by the Council with the result that they may be made available to the public under the Local Government (Access to Information) Act 1985.
