**NOTICE OF MAKING OF AN ORDER

PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER

**FOOTPATH 16 HIGH EASTER
IN THE DISTRICT OF UTTLESFORD**

The above order, made on 9th March 2020, under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980, will divert a part length of Footpath 16 commencing from just north of the pond at Crippings Farm running to the west of the grain silos, through an area of scrub and trees and along a field headland on the southern side of a hedge onto a new route along a track on the eastern side of the silos then onto a field headland on the northern side of the hedge for approximately 160 metres to a field corner where it continues unaffected.

Any representations about or objections to the order may be sent in writing to Roy Read, Definitive Map Service, Essex County Council, Seax House, 2nd Floor, Victoria Road South, Chelmsford CM1 1QH no later than 11th February 2021. Please state the grounds on which they are made.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, Essex County Council may confirm the order as an unopposed order. If the order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation any representations or objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent together with the order. Any such representations or objections will be taken into account by the Council with the result that they may be made available to the public under the Local Government (Access to Information) Act 1985.
